

Thank you and I hope that we will see each other again in Timisoara, Romania.



Timișoara is the capital city of Timiș County, Banat, and the main economic, social and cultural centre in Western Romania. Located on the Bega River, Timișoara is considered the informal capital city of the historical Banat region.

Timișoara has the most diverse ethnic and confessional structure in Romania, with 21 ethnic groups from 18 religious denominations living here in harmony and tolerance. Timișoara is home to more than 300,000 inhabitants, plus a vibrant student community. More than 45,000 young people study in Timișoara's universities.

Rain or shine, in Timişoara you have over 900 reasons to go out for a walk.

This is the number of heritage buildings in the city, Timişoara having the largest area of historical monuments in Romania. Each with its own story. Each with its own place. Waiting to be discovered.

Victoriei Square

The newest square in the Cetate district is today the centre of the city. The story began with the de-fortification of Timisoara (early years of the 20th century), when a boulevard was designed and built, which existed until the late 1980s. Beautiful 1900s-style palaces are built at a dizzying pace between 1910 and 1914. One of Europe's first tram lines was here until 1987. The two long sides of the square were the walking places of the locals: the left side (as you look towards the Cathedral) was called "Surogat" and the right side was called "Corso" and represented the place for the "good folk" to stroll.

Palace of Culture

Probably the most emblematic building of Timisoara. It was built between 1872 and 1875, in Neo-Renaissance style, after the design of the Viennese architects Helmer and Fellner. The building was the victim of fires in the 1890s and 1920s. During the second restoration, the auditorium was decorated in neo-Romanesque style. In the 1930s, the Bucharest architect Duiliu Marcu restored the main façade in the form of a triumphal arch. In 2003, the main façade was restored to its present form. After the 1989 Revolution, the building's balcony has a strong historical significance, being the place from which Timisoara declared itself the first city in Romania free from communism. The building now houses four cultural institutions: the National Theatre, the Romanian Opera, the German Theatre, and the Hungarian Theatre.







Libertății Square

Over time, the market's appearance has changed. During the Ottoman period it was the site of the public baths, the bazaar, and the great barn. The remains of the baths were excavated in 2014, and the outline of the walls and the pillars supporting the floor are marked on the pavement of the square and can be easily identified on a walk. The layout of the square we see today dates from the 1700s, during the Habsburg period, when it was called Paradeplatz (Parade Square) and was the administrative centre of the town. It's no coincidence that the Old Town Hall is located on the north side of the square. The square has recently been renovated and has been transformed from a heavily vegetated square to an event square. It now hosts open-air shows and concerts, the Christmas Fair, as well as terraces and resting places.

Maria Theresa Bastion

It is the only one standing today of the nine original bastions of the Vauban fortress, built between 1732-1765 by the Habsburg administration. The bastion housed the 'proviant' (food storehouse) and the powder magazine. The fortress was star-shaped in plan, its nine bastions representing the corners of the star, three fortification rings and two water ditches. Attacked only once, during the 1848 Revolution, the fortress withstood the 107- day siege. It now houses cafes and restaurants, cultural spaces, and sections of the Banat Museum.









Useful information



Emergency number - 112 is the universal emergency number available throughout the country, which can be dialed from all public telephone networks.



Telephony - in Romania, there are 4 mobile phone networks. For EU residents, there are no additional charges for roaming.



Wifi - most establishments (terraces, restaurants) offer free WiFi. You just need to ask for the password. Some public places (parks, squares) or shopping centers offer password-free WiFi.



Electricity - each country has different types of plugs. Romania uses Type C and Type F plugs, operating on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.



Weather - Up-to-date weather information can be accessed at www.meteoblue.com.



Parking - Most of the streets in the central area are included in the <u>Timpark</u> parking system. The tariff zones are marked with plates of different colors.



Local Currency & Banks - The local currency used for cash payments is the Romanian Leu (RON). Additionally, credit cards are accepted almost everywhere.



Connection to the airport - The connection to Traian Vuia International Airport is provided by buses **E4** and **E4b**, which operate between the Bastion and Airport stations, as well as between the North Railway Station and Airport. Details regarding the schedules for E4 and E4b can be found on the STPT website.



Tickets & fares - **Tickets** (4 lei - 60 minutes) can be purchased on the bus with a bank card, through SMS, or using the <u>24pay</u> or <u>mobilPay</u> applications. Paper tickets can be purchased from STPT kiosks and must be validated upon boarding the bus.



Bicycles - You can borrow bicycles for free within the municipality of Timişoara. For assistance, please approach an employee at an STPT kiosk
